## 1. Introduction

- 1.1. The purpose of this report is to provide an update to the Trust Board on the progress in implementing the homicide action plans.

## 2. Analysis and Discussion

- 2.1. The table below shows the status of recommendation implementation by each of the published inquiries:

### 2.2. SN Action Plan

All actions in relation to the independent inquiry report have been completed and the Trust is awaiting confirmation from the Strategic Health Authority and Lead Commissioner that this action plan can be closed.

### 2.3. MH Action Plan

All actions in relation to the independent inquiry report have been completed and NHS Gloucestershire have expressed their satisfaction with progress. The Trust is awaiting confirmation from the Strategic Health Authority and Lead Commissioner that this action plan can be closed.

### 2.4. MR X Action Plan

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From eleven actions on this action plan, nine are green (completed) and two are amber (underway).

The outstanding actions require the Trust to carry out service user and partner agency satisfaction reports in Swindon once Adults of Working Age Community redesign and the Primary Care Liaison Service (PCLS) implementation are completed. Since both of these steps have now been completed recently, the Adults of Working Age Community and Liaison and Later Life Strategic Business Units are going to produce a report in September 2012 for completion in October 2012 which will involve NHS Swindon. The report will include results from a service user satisfaction survey to be undertaken in early September by PCLS.

NHS Gloucestershire have expressed their satisfaction with progress.

2.5. Mr B Action Plan

Since last month's report, two further actions are now graded green (from amber) and work continues to address the remainder, as described in last month's report.

2.6. Mr Y Action Plan

Of the twenty three recommendations, two are red (not yet started), eight are amber (underway) and thirteen are green (completed). This is unchanged from last month's report which provided a detailed status briefing on the work underway.

2.7. Legacy Action Plan

All actions in relation to the independent inquiry report have been completed and the Trust is awaiting confirmation from the Strategic Health Authority and Lead Commissioner that this action plan can be closed.

2.8. Embargoed Action Plans

Two reports remain embargoed but the Trust has drafted action plans which have been sent to the Strategic Health Authority for their approval. The third inquiry has completed but the Trust has not yet had sight of the draft report.

2.9. Internal Homicide Action Plans

The Trust has two internal action plans underway that have not yet reached inquiry. Good progress has been made in respect of these action plans but they are not yet concluded.

### 3. Conclusion

3.1. The Trust attempted to make a proposal to its Lead Commissioner on how agreement can be reached to close the completed action plans, however the Lead Commissioner chose to defer that discussion, which will presumably be rescheduled.
